

Curriculum

MPI is a homogeneous program where students attend and graduate the same disciplines. This format allows the graduation after **4 semesters**. Semesters 1 to 3 comprise 4-5 disciplines, organized in modules of 2-3 weeks each. Each module ends with an exam. The total number of credits of the Program is 120, according to ECTS system. The program is concluded after the defense of the dissertation and by obtaining a Master Diploma issued by the Romanian Ministry of National Education.

The curriculum of the Master Program in Management of International Projects is structured by taking into consideration the needs of a project manager. The program starts with a general preparation semester that offers the fundamental knowledge for the subsequent specialized semesters.

The number of available places in the Program for the academic year 2016-2017 is 50, of which 20 are budget-financed places.

The tuition is 4000 lei per year for the academic year 2016-2017. It covers the attendance to courses, seminars and projects, course materials in electronic format, dissertation defense, use of the Faculty training facilities, as well as student registration.
